- Help with hospital or other health services enquires

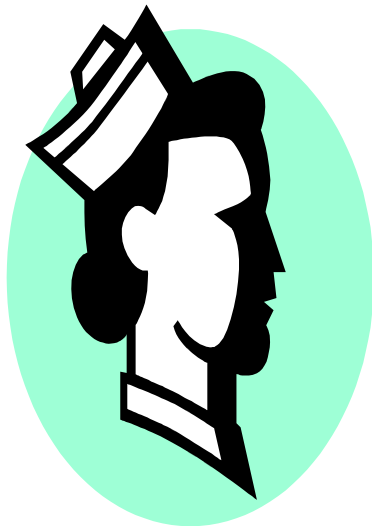
**All staff at Hendford Lodge Medical Centre are signed up to our confidential and information governance procedures.**
