PLEASE READ THESE NOTES CAREFULLY:

- Once you have completed the form you can make an appointment in the Travel Clinic to see a Travel Nurse
- It is better to do this well in advance of your departure date, as some vaccinations must be started several months before you leave the country
- If you leave your vaccination schedule too late then we may not be able to provide you with a full course of vaccinations. If that is the case we might recommend that you cancel or postpone your trip. That is the best way to ensure the vaccinations and medication you have been given are effective before you travel
- Ensure your exact travel locations and plans are organised before you attend your first appointment, otherwise it is impossible to advise which vaccinations and malaria prevention you will need
- If you have a written record of any past vaccinations please BRING it with you to all Travel Clinic appointments
- There is no charge for information and advice provided in our Travel Clinic if you are a patient within the Saville Medical Group. However not all vaccinations and medication are provided free by the NHS. If there are charges the nurse will advise you, or you can ask at College Suite Reception **0191 2428299**
- If you are a private patient and registered with a different GP surgery the charges for travel advice and vaccinations will be different, please ask at College Suite Reception **0191 2428299**
- The first appointment is for 30 minutes and if appropriate your first vaccinations may begin on that day. Your second appointment for further vaccinations will be made when you attend the first appointment
- We cannot give any vaccinations if you are unwell on the day of your appointment. If so, please cancel your appointment and make a new one when you are well again
- After your first appointment subsequent visits are for vaccinations only so if you change your travel plans you will be asked to book a new appointment so you can be given additional advice
- Please be aware that for some vaccinations you must wait 30 minutes in our waiting room in case you have a reaction to the vaccine
- We take all means of payment for vaccination
