‘Your Health Matters’

Meeting held on Tuesday 10 February at 5pm at Cheviot Medical Centre to discuss Health Awareness Day and Coffee Morning

Lorna reported that following receipt of contract for use of Glendale Hall, it was felt that as a PPG with no insurance cover, this contract could not be signed. Following discussion with Caroline Douglas and Chris James, it was agreed that LM would go back to Margaret Brown of United Reform PPC to discuss matter further. LM was to check that they had Public Liability that would adequately cover the Coffee Morning and the Health Awareness Day. This to be put in writing. It was agreed to carry on with arrangements for Coffee Morning and HA Day, in the hope that this situation can be resolved positively.

Coffee Morning – Wednesday 4 March, Glendale Hall 9.30 – 11.30 (approx)

Chris James suggested making up a hamper as separate raffle prize, Teresa offered to organize board 1-100. All cakes will be picked up from surgery by Sue Wade on morning of coffee morning at 9am.
